REQUIREMENTS FOR PERMITTING PERMANENT GENERATORS:

We will issue (1) one permit for a generator to either an electrical contractor or an owner/builder. They will list the gas contractor and the gas company (if applicable) on the permit application. The information required at the time of application is this completed form, a completed permit application, owner/builder affidavit (if applicable), (1) one site plan (with below information shown) and a Notice of Commencement (if job is valued at \$2500.00 or more).

- _____ Identify scale to which the site plan is prepared – (example 1/4”=1’)

- _____ The distance of setbacks from adjacent property lines
- _____ All driveways, sidewalks, walkways and/or paved areas
- _____ Generator _____ Fuel source _____ Propane tank location (If applicable)
- _____ Propane tank location (if applicable) _____ Highlight area of work for this projects
- _____ Generator meets set back requirements and is not in any easement
- _____ Distance shown from property lines to all structures
