Dear Ms. Raftery:

In light of most Volusia cities facing a deadline to certify the elections held on November 4, 2014 I wanted to share the results of votes cast. The results of the City of Deltona election are as follows:

For Deltona Mayor, the whole number of votes cast was 23125 of which number

Zenaida Denizac received 11443 votes
John Masiarczyk received 11682 votes

For Deltona Commissioner Zone 1, the whole number of votes cast was 3066 of which number

Mitch Honaker received 1625 votes
Michael W Pulkowski received 1441 votes

For Deltona Commissioner Zone 5, the whole number of votes cast was 3633 of which number

Victor Ramos received 1661 votes
Brian Soukup received 1972 votes

For Municipal Referendum #1-City Charter Amendment Removing initial incorporation/transition provisions, boundary descriptions and changing candidate qualifying provisions:

YES received 14730 votes
NO received 7445 votes

For Municipal Referendum #2-City charter amendment removing city manager residency requirement:

YES received 5377 votes
NO received 17245 votes

For Municipal Referendum #4-City charter amendment removing in-house attorney residency requirement:

YES received 7001 votes
NO received 15681 votes

The law changed in 2014 regarding overseas military and domestic absentee ballots. Departments of Elections statewide are now required to count all votes cast in all elections (as opposed to just federal elections). In practical terms it rarely makes a difference. Very few overseas absentees are returned after Election Day. The City of Deltona has 56 outstanding overseas absentee ballots. These ballots will be counted by the canvassing board on Friday, November 14, 2014 beginning at 3:00 pm. I will update your report and send an official certification to you upon conclusion of the canvassing board meeting.
