There was discussion about a few vendors who had complaints about their placement; not enough room between them and their neighbor; and some who had an excessive amount of people at their table. A note was made to reiterate to the vendors that no more than 3 people are allowed at a table. It was noted that there were no complaints from the public.

The overall consensus was that the event, as usual, was a complete success based on the vendor and public feedback.

B. New Topics of Interest for 2015

The sub-committee continued their discussion for Part II of the video recording which would focus on indoor space including entrances and restrooms. There was also discussion about educating businesses on parking issues and accessible entry.

Mr. Moore mentioned that he would speak with Captain Eagan, the new Sheriff for the Deltona area, and ask him to come to the next meeting to talk about handicap violations and local businesses. There was discussion about this sub-committee creating a pamphlet for businesses as a way of educating them. Mr. Moore said that by informing the businesses, it would be more in line with the roll of what this sub-committee should be doing. The members could also establish a date by which these businesses should be in compliance.

Mrs. Beauregard mentioned that ADA would be 25 years old on July 22nd.
