

**CITY OF DELTONA, FLORIDA  
REGULAR MEETING  
CITIZEN ACCESSIBILITY ADVISORY SUB COMMITTEE  
THURSDAY, MAY 15, 2014**

A Regular Meeting of the Citizen Accessibility Advisory Sub Committee was held on Thursday, May 15, 2014 in the Commission Chambers Kitchen, 2345 Providence Boulevard, Deltona, Florida.

**1. CALL TO ORDER:**

The meeting was called to order at 5:48 p.m. by the Chair, Julio DeLeon.

**3. APPROVAL OF MINUTES:**

**A. Minutes:**

**1. Minutes – April 17, 2014, 2014**

**Motion by Thomas Dockery, seconded by Mickey Beauregard, to adopt the minutes of the Regular Citizen Accessibility Advisory Sub Committee Meeting of April 17, 2014.**

**4. ANNOUNCEMENTS:**

Mrs. Brown handed out the Flow Mobile information for April as well as the Bee Healthy Deltona flyer. She thanked Miss Denizac for all her work on the flyer.

**5. PUBLIC COMMENT:**

There were no members from the public present for this meeting.

**6. OLD BUSINESS:**

**a. Community Health Expo discussion:**

The members were told that there were now 4 sponsors: Mrs. Brown told them that Insight Credit Union was now on board as a sponsor as well Brain Trust, who would be providing the breakfast for the event; and Electrical Solutions was sponsoring the face painter for the children. There were 27 vendors signed up to date which included one vendor for the courtyard. Mrs. Brown announced that someone had called from Autism about a room rental and she had asked them to participate in the event which they agreed to do. That was just sheer coincidence. Mrs. Dockery was still trying to make contact with the Epilepsy Foundation but so far no response. Ms. Beauregard advised the same thing. Mrs. Brown told Mrs. Dockery that she would give her the breakfast list in a few days.

Mrs. Brown stated that One Blood would have a table indoor with a different service than what would be provided by the Big Red Bus on site.

Mrs. Brown also advised that Florida Hospital Fish Memorial, as a sponsor, would be delivering bags and goodies so the sub-committee would be able to help with that. Miss Beauregard and Mr. DeLeon advised that they were both off on Mondays so that would be a good day to stuff the bags. Mrs. Brown advised that as soon as the items were received she would call them about coming in. The only thing that would need to be done on the Friday before the event would be to decorate the chambers and place the tent cards for the vendors on the tables. Ms. Beauregard advised that she would not be here for the expo.

The members did not have any issues. They were happy with the progress of the event and the variety of vendors.

**b. ADA discussions:**

The members were given a copy of the 2013 Florida Statutes as well as a handout Program Series called "What are the rules for handicapped parking?" Mr. Moore advised them to review it so it could be discussed at the June meeting.

**7. NEW BUSINESS:**

**a. Information/Updates – Steve Moore:**

Mr. Moore told the members about the ribbon cutting ceremony at Harris Saxon for the Born Learning Trail, sponsored by Kiwanis. He said there were about 30 people in attendance including the Mayor and some Commissioners. He said the Early Learning Coalition of Volusia/Flagler would be responsible for getting the people to participate on the trail as they are an outreach organization. He added that this was the only one of its kind currently in Volusia County. He advised that Kiwanis built the trail, paid for the signs and would be responsible for maintaining it. It included games for children with different shapes and was for the younger age kids ages 2-5 year old.

**8. DIRECTOR COMMENTS:**

Mr. Moore told the members that the City was in the middle of the budget process. He said in the new year the Parks Department would be building a field at Wes Crile Park and a new field at Dwight Hawkins. He indicated that we are looking to develop a 122 acre parcel off Alexander, behind Discovery Elementary including some fields and if the sale of Dupont Lakes goes through, then some of that money would be used to develop that parcel.

Mr. Moore also told them that we are looking to build some trails on property currently owned, to help promote the eco-tourism and that would be in the budget.

He told the members that everyone really enjoyed the jazz player at the last Concert in the Amphitheater. Some of the members agreed with him and said the player really knew how to work the crowd. They were also pleased with the food trucks.

Miss Denizac mentioned that we might want to consider the kids who stand on the walls at the amphitheater.

## **9. MEMBER COMMENTS:**

Ms. Beauregard advised that she will be absent from the June meeting.

The Adopt-A-Bench program was brought up and it was noted that Parks & Recreation was no longer doing that project. There was discussion about environmentally friendly benches and replacing the metal ones.

Miss Denizac said she was looking forward to the expo.

Mrs. Dockery said she was excited about the expo. She had handed the flyer to her local neighborhood watch group so they could put it in their announcements at the neighborhood meeting.

Mr. Dockery said the Volunteer Luncheon and the Concert in the Amphitheater were great. He talked about ADA parking and wanted to know if the City would host a class with the Sheriff, Fire and EMT about how to deal with handicap people. Miss Beauregard said she does something for the Sheriff for Volusia and Flagler County, focusing on Autism, similar to what Mr. Dockery was saying.

Mr. Moore said we were not qualified to do that and he was sure the EMT personnel were trained in that area.

Miss Beauregard apologized for not providing the bench information and said she will give her input before she leaves.

Mr. DeLeon said he was looking forward to the expo.
