Mr. Moore began by introducing Deltona's new City Manager, Ms. Shang to members. The members welcomed her to the meeting and re-capped what had been discussed regarding the upcoming Sweetheart Dinner.

Ms. Shang informed members on the planning of the new Community Center. Stating that the current plans are that of a \$8.9 million, 25,000 square foot of space for the senior community plus an additional 20,000 square foot gymnasium. The architectural engineering design has been awarded to a firm in Orlando, FL who has built other local Community Centers. The city has begun some pulmonary work at the site behind Fire Station 65 and the goal is to have the building up and operating by December 2017.
