Deltona plans first Festival of Nations


Aug. 27, 2015—Deltona is likely the most diverse City in Volusia County. Volunteers along with Deltona Parks & Recreation are planning the first “Festival of Nations” to showcase Deltona’s diversity.

On Sept. 19, residents and visitors will gather at the Dewey O. Boster Sports Complex for a day of free, non-stop ethnic music, dance and the most diverse array of food and crafts in the area. The event is tentatively scheduled to be from noon to 6 p.m. The festival’s planning committee has been working on a lineup to include performers from Bulgaria, Romania, Panama, Germany, Africa, Peru, the Philippines, Mexico, Puerto Rico and the United States. Also food vendors from Trinidad, Africa, India, Puerto Rico and the United States are making plans to be at the City’s festival.

The deadline to get involved is Sept. 16. Vendors who wish to sell international food and/or arts and crafts may apply online for a space at the event prior to Sept. 16. The cost is \$25.
